► Initial situation ...

- Development of an Android app for a start up (Wire Swiss GmbH) development team in Berlin
- Two teams in separate locations, approx. 14 team members
- 7 developers, rest UX, QA etc.

- Development ongoing for over a year
- Affected by repeated delays & deferrals
- Stakeholders and team unhappy with deadline compliance

- 20th August 2014
Call from scrum master / product owner

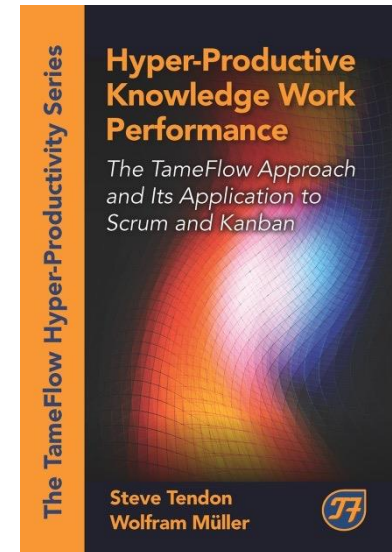
► Intervention: two immediate steps ...

1. Reduce work in progress to an absolute minimum
2. Determine a due-date with a reasonable buffer and monitor buffer consumption

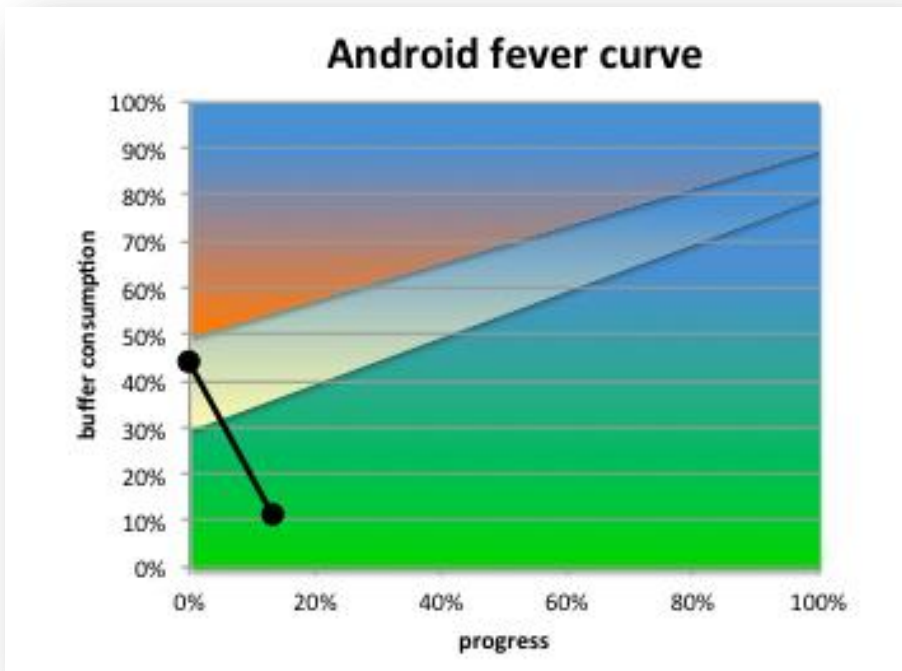
► Step 1. Reduce WIP to the Minimum ...

... goal: fewer tasks than developers

- *Within 8 days the WIP was reduced from ratio of 1:8 to 1:2.5*
- *That's a reduction to one third of the original, achieved by simply stopping to take on additional tasks*

► Step 2. Determine Buffer and start CCPM Fever Curve

September 8



First fever curve was drawn

Due date set for November 4th based on an expected velocity increase of +10%

Report progress every week

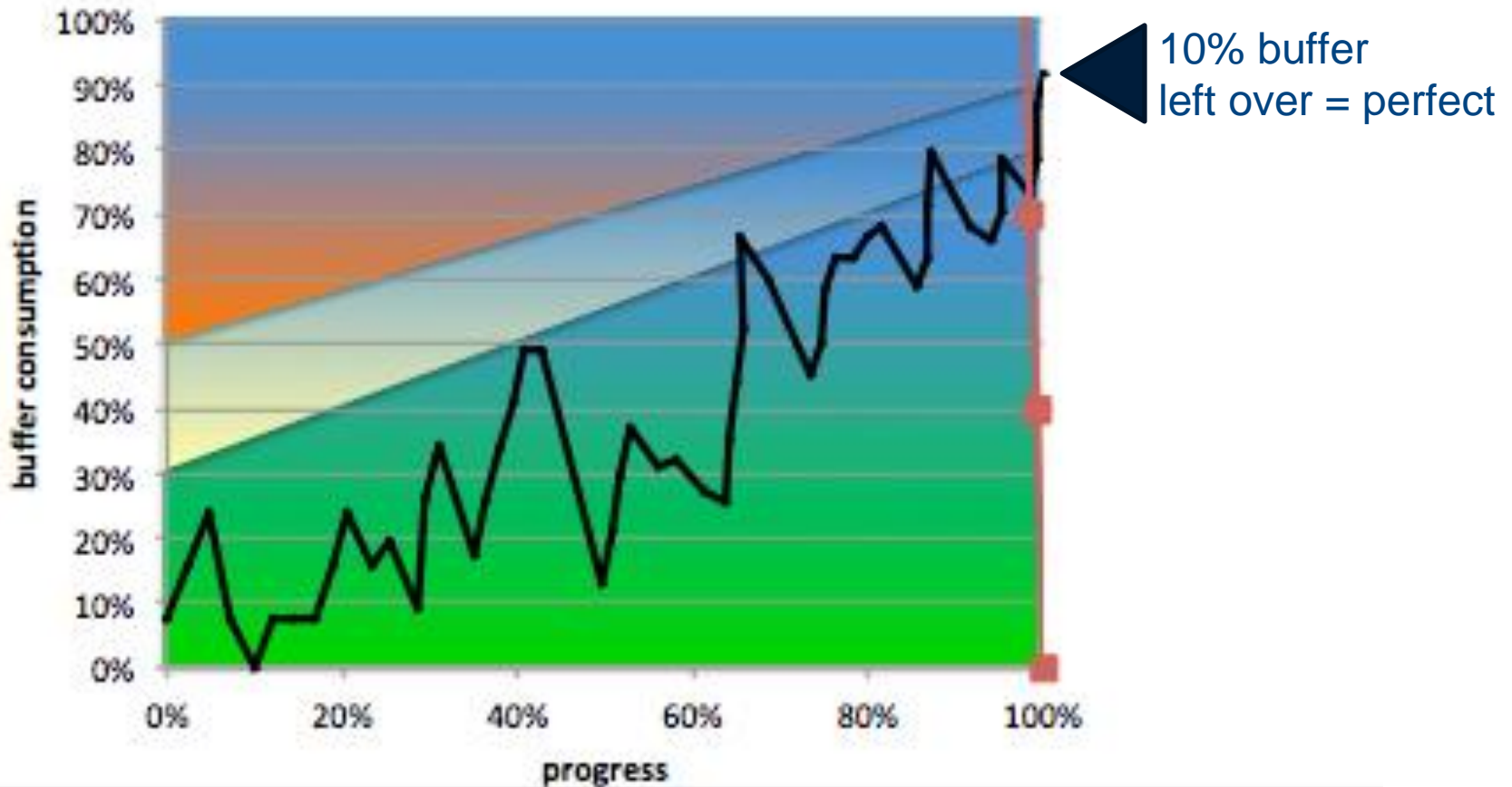
What you see here is a very typical jump into the green.

This is caused by two effects:

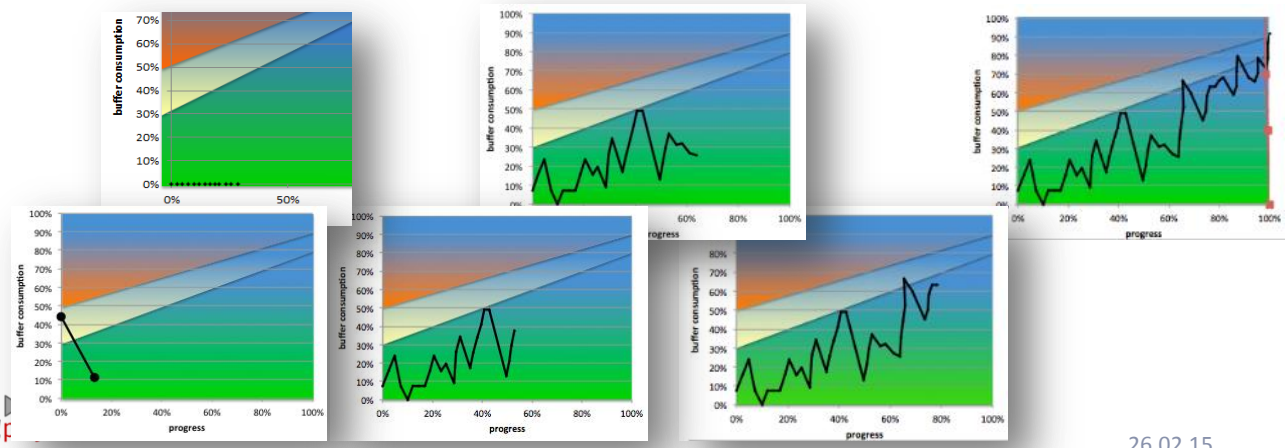
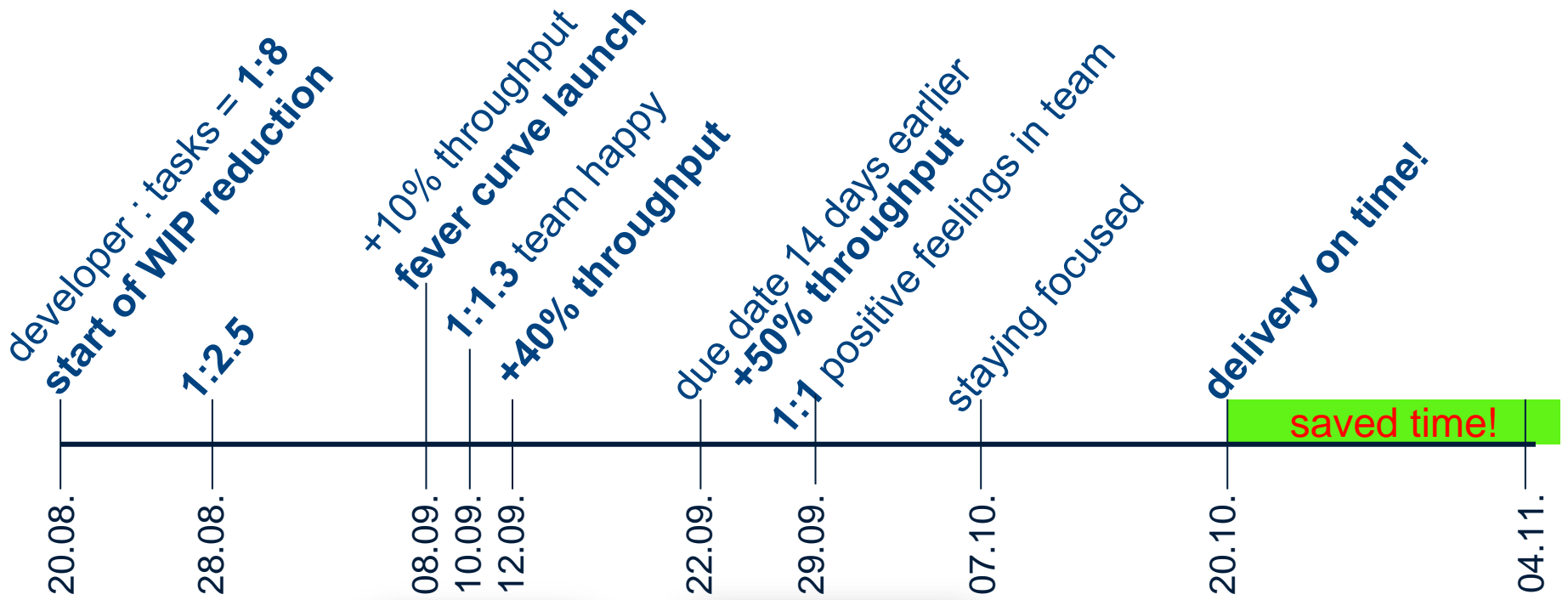
1. on task per developer makes all hidden obstacles visible immediately, forcing the team to resolve them; velocity jumps up.
2. by showing a dedicated buffer the „fear“ in the team disappears – as a result hidden buffers get freed up

- ▶ **Goal reached – feature completed on time!**
Sped up by two weeks and +50% increased throughput

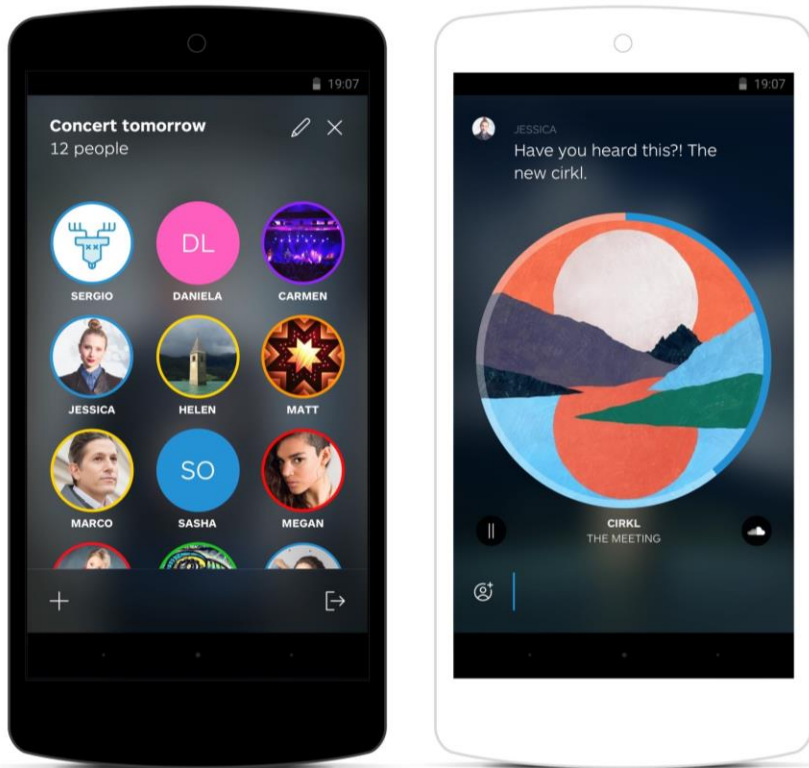
Android fever curve
